Students participating in the Concurrent or ASCENT Enrollment Program may choose to participate as a full-time student. The chart below is a guide to help parents understand the difference between a home-based/part-time student and a full-time student. The full-time program is open to students who transfer from a traditional public school setting, or students who transfer from home-based/Part-time time program. It is important for previously home-based students and their parents to understand the impact of becoming a full-time student. The chart below outlines the differences according to Colorado homeschool law, *C.R.S. 22:33:104.5. Home-based education – legislative – definitions – guidelines.*
